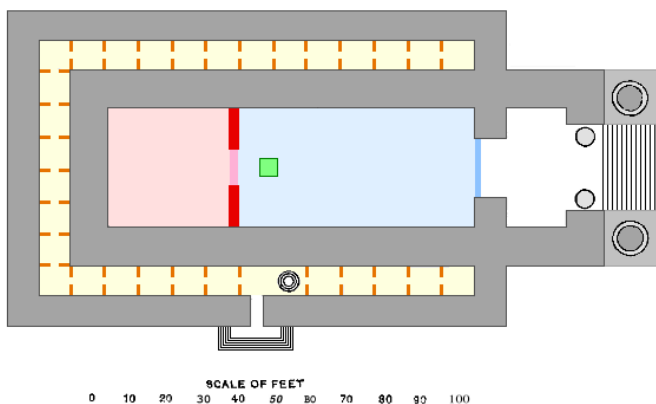
Psalm 97:1–3 (NIV)
