Your Giving

When we talk about "Church Finance" we mean "what we do with the money you give". We don't get Government support, or money from some central CoFE fund, it's all from giving, and all supports our work in the name of Jesus Christ - so thank you!

"Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Corinthians 9:7)

Budget

Your Church Council (the 'District Church Council', or DCC) has again this year put together a budget to help us manage our finance with care. For 2020, we've set a **target** for our giving, which includes giving specific amounts to our **Mission Partners**.

"Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,' says the LORD Almighty, 'and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing ...'" (Malachi 3:10)

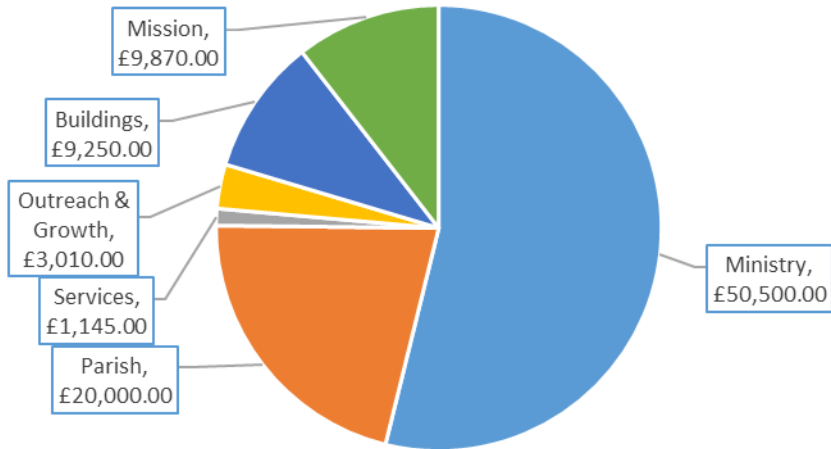
Target

We think that we need around £94,000 for this year. Over the page there's a diagram of how we get that figure...

"Ministry" goes towards the cost of supporting Clergy. The Rector's stipend is about £26,600 but there are many other costs (buildings, training, Diocesan staff etc).

"Buildings" includes energy costs, and some maintenance

"Outreach and Growth" is a remarkably low amount but covers the important costs of doing these vital parts of our mission.



Mission Support

By giving to support our Mission Partners, we join with them in their Gospel work, to the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

For 2020 about 10% of our budget will be sent to Mission Partners. This means that everyone who gives will be contributing towards this.

The East Window Refurbishment

We are stewards of our historic buildings and the time has come for major repairs to the large stained-glass window and stone surround at the East end of the building. The estimated cost of this is £160,000 which is covered by a grant from the Suez Community Fund and from the balance of our "Ivy Morris Fund" (which we had planned to spend on interior redecoration). The project should last from March – September 2020.

At the moment our giving is about £250 less than we need each month.

We're very grateful for everything that is given, in whatever way it has been given – thank you! Do look up the Bible passages quoted in the leaflet and see their context. Please pray, asking for wisdom to know how much to give.
