Muffin case poppies

What you need:

- muffin liners
- scissors
- red paint/brushes or pens
- buttons optional – alternatively use coloured paper or white paper coloured in.
- glue



What you do:

1. To ensure you have one large and one small liner per poppy, make some of the liners smaller by cutting the top edge off with scissors.
2. Paint/colour in the muffin liners and let them dry.
3. Place the smaller muffin liner inside the larger and crinkle into shape.
4. Glue buttons or small black paper circle into the centre.
5. Now you can either ...make several and glue to paper to make a poppy field; attach a safety pin to the back to make a badge; selotape to a lolly stick or attach to a pipe cleaner.
